In the identified area, the current year population is 11,898. In 2010, the Census count in the area was 11,581. The rate of change since 2010 was 0.37% annually. The five-year projection for the population in the area is 12,101 representing a change of 0.34% annually from 2017 to 2022. Currently, the population is 50.3% male and 49.7% female.

Persons of Hispanic origin represent 3.0% of the population in the identified area compared to 18.1% of the U.S. population. Persons of Hispanic Origin may be of any race. The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 11.6 in the identified area, compared to 64.0 for the U.S. as a whole.

Current median household income is \$53,833 in the area, compared to \$56,124 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$60,936 in five years, compared to \$62,316 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$65,706 in this area, compared to \$80,675 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$75,652 in five years, compared to \$91,585 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$25,337 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$30,820. The per capita income is projected to be \$29,142 in five years, compared to \$34,828 for all U.S. households

Currently, 74.5% of the 4,996 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 16.8%, renter occupied; and 8.7% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.6% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 33.1% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 4,848 housing units in the area - 75.7% owner occupied, 15.9% renter occupied, and 8.4% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.35%. Median home value in the area is \$131,704, compared to a median home value of \$207,344 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 4.03% annually to \$160,436.
